Scope of Position: This position will support Animal Medical Services Clinic and programs by providing cleaning and maintenance of all animal kennels and general custodial duties within the clinic.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Custodial duties
- Report any concerns regarding animals to appropriate staff
- Maintain a healthy, safe, and sanitary environment according to OSHA standards for all animals and people in the veterinary medical facility at all times.
