Companion Animals at Large

The Dane County Humane Society (DCHS) encourages guardians to keep their companion animals indoors or properly supervised. Companion animals running at large are at risk for injury or abduction. In addition, if frightened or threatened, these unsupervised animals can also pose a threat to the safety of the public and other animals. DCHS encourages the creation of laws prohibiting companion animals running at large and supports such existing laws.
