Rabies Vaccinations

Rabies potentially poses a serious health threat to wild and domestic animals, as well as humans. Therefore the Dane County Humane Society (DCHS) considers rabies vaccinations of dogs and cats a necessary protective measure and strongly recommends it to all dog and cat guardians.

DCHS considers such vaccinations as essential component of responsible pet guardianship and supports legislation that require compulsory vaccination of domestic pets.
